

PARK PAVILION & CHAPEL GUIDE



Fountain Park: \$100/DAY

901 East Fountain Blvd

Maximum Capacity: 50 People

Seats: Approximately 20 People

Facilities: Basketball, playground, youth bike park, and multi-use field.

Does not include any access to Hillside Community Center.



Monument Valley Park: \$150/DAY

170 West Cache La Poudre St

Maximum Capacity: 200 People

Seats: Approximately 48 People

Facilities: Electricity Available (+\$50), restrooms available during summer months, playground, trails, basketball, sand volleyball, pickleball courts, and YMCA outdoor pool (summer)



Nancy Lewis Park: \$100/DAY

2615 Logan Avenue

Maximum Capacity: 50 People

Seats: Approximately 14 People

Facilities: Restrooms available during summer months, waterfall/fountain, croquet/putting green, sand volleyball, playground with fitness equipment, multi-use field, sidewalk trail

Maximum Capacity: 100 People

Seats: Approximately 72 People

Facilities: Electricity Available (+\$50), restrooms available during summer months, hiking trails

Seats: Approximately 84 People

Facilities: Restrooms available during summer months, nearby walking, jogging, mountain biking trails

Facilities: Restrooms available during summer months, playground, ballfield, and multi-use field

Maximum Capacity: 135 People

Seats: Approximately 85 People

Facilities: Electricity (+\$50), restrooms available during summer months, playground, basketball, tennis, pickleball, artificial turf multi-use fields, trails, sprayground (summer)



Venezia Community Park House: \$175/DAY

Maximum Capacity: 150 People

Seats: Approximately 85 People

Facilities: Electricity (+\$50), restrooms available during summer months, playground, basketball, tennis, pickleball, artificial turf multi-use fields, trails, sprayground (summer)



Venezia Community Park Barn: \$250/DAY

Maximum Capacity: 225 People

Seats: Approximately 175 People

Facilities: Electricity (+\$50), restrooms available during summer months, playground, basketball, tennis, pickleball, artificial turf multi-use fields, trails, sprayground (summer)

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American Mother's Chapel at Rock Ledge Ranch: \$200/DAY

Intersection of 31st Street and Chambers Way

Maximum Capacity: 15 People

Seats: 12 People

- Ceremony parking is only on Chambers Way
- Chapel reservations do not apply to any other part of the Rock Ledge Ranch Historic Site including the parking lot.
- Under no circumstances may
- a motor vehicle park next to the Chapel or inside the Park fence line
- There is a heater/air conditioner unit in the chapel for ceremony use.
- The Chapel is in a natural area. Do not release birds, butterflies, throw rice or confetti.
- Flowers or other decorations should not be delivered early or left after use.
- No restrooms or changing areas on-site.

Park Rules (ALL APPLY)

- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in City Parks by Ordinance No 9.9.410
- Parking/Vehicular Access: Motorized vehicles of all types including golf carts, gators, ATVs, etc, are strictly prohibited on park property, lawns, turf, restricted roadway, bicycle/pedestrian pathways, canal, creek pathways, turf trail or athletic fields. All cars must be parked in designated parking areas.
- Trash and debris must be disposed of properly and area must be clean.
- No grills are allowed in City parks.
- It is unlawful for any person to injure, deface, destroy, sever or remove any park property.
- If you are using amplified equipment for your picnic or event, you will need to obtain a Noise Hardship Permit through the Colorado Springs Police Department. Please contact CSPD at (719) 444-7705 regarding noise permits.

If you plan to have any type of inflatable or bounce house, exceed pavilion capacity, impact public use or require exclusive use of the park, depend on public participation or require an entry fee, and/or have vendors, generators, tents/canopies, you will need to obtain a Park Special Event Permit.
